

Registration Form for Animal Eye Care
OFA ECR (Eye Registration) Clinic
Held Twice Yearly in May and November

By Pre-Registration ONLY: Closes when limit of 60 dogs is reached. **All fees must be prepaid in full, in U.S. funds.** NOTE: ACVO Diplomates perform OFA ECR (Eye Certification Registry) exams and not CERF exams. The OFA ECR exam is identical to a CERF exam. For questions, please visit www.offa.org.

Here are our Eye Registration Clinic rules:

1. Please call us to schedule an appointment time. Payment is due at the time you call and schedule the appointment. Credit cards are accepted, but we do not keep credit card numbers on file at our office. Cash is not accepted.
2. Checks are only accepted if we receive them no later than 12 business days prior to the Clinic. We will not hold your check, but will deposit it as it is received.
3. If your appointment is scheduled less than 12 business days prior to the Clinic, you must pay by credit card at the time the appointment is scheduled.
4. Please mail or fax in the registration form, to be received no later than TWO business days prior to the Clinic. Please enclose a copy of your dog's AKC, CKC, or litter registration for each dog and one permanent ID number (microchip, tattoo, or DNA profile number) if available. An AKC or CKC registration number is desired, but not mandatory. The dog's registered name and birth date are needed.

In consideration and respect of confidentiality while at this Clinic, please refrain from asking other owners present what their dogs' exam results are, and discussing your own results. The Clinic is performed by board-certified ophthalmologist Dr. Terri McCalla and is for genetic screening only. Do NOT bring dogs with eye injuries or other conditions requiring treatment. **Please refrain from bringing dogs in heat whenever possible.** If this is unavoidable, please segregate your dog until it is ready to be examined, and then remove it immediately. **Unruly or fractious animals will NOT be examined.** NOTE: All dogs will be scanned for the presence of a microchip, and the chip number (if a chip is present) verified on the OFA ECR form.

COST: OFA ECR examination \$35.00 per dog

PLEASE ARRIVE 1/2 HOUR PRIOR TO YOUR SCHEDULED APPOINTMENT TIME FOR EYE DROPS. If you are more than 20 minutes late, we will not be able to work you back into the schedule and the fee is not refundable.
